

A FAMILY TRADITION OF FINE WINES

Klingshirn Winery is a third generation family farm winery established in the fall of 1935. A large surplus grape crop prompted Albert R. Klingshirn to begin producing wine commercially, in twenty 50 gallon wooden barrels in the cellar of his home.

Five years later Albert built a small winery consisting of two levels. The basement housed the fermentation tanks and two hundred 50 gallon wooden barrels. The small ground level room served as a Bottling/Storage/Sales Room. The wine press was stored on a nearby farm.

Albert's son, Allan, purchased the farm and winery in 1955 and began expanding the product line. As the business grew, small barrels were replaced by larger wooden casks and stainless steel tanks.

In 1978 the winery was expanded to four times its original size. The building was now large enough to contain all the production facilities and a retail sales room.

Allan's youngest son, Lee, graduated from Ohio State University in 1986 with a Bachelors Degree in Viticulture and Enology. He is now the wine maker and works with his parents to continue the family tradition.

During the fall harvest, customers often observe the pressing operations. At this time, much of the juice is sold fresh from the press for drinking, jelly making, freezing or home winemaking.

Knowledgeable employees are available to help customers with their selections of wines and champagnes along with the amount to serve.

Informal tasting is permitted and informal tours are welcomed when time permits. Appointments for formal group tours of up to 25 people must be prearranged. The formal tour includes wine tasting with cheese and crackers, and requires a small fee. Tours are not available during harvest season.

WINES

1998 CABERNET SAUVIGNON: A dry red, oak aged, full bodied varietal with a hearty aroma and taste.

CHAMBOURCIN: A nearly dry dark red varietal with a hint of oak for a well- rounded character.

1999 CHARDONNAY: A dry white varietal wine balanced in oak and varietal flavors.

CONCORD: A dry red varietal wine featuring the traditional concord grape flavor.

WHITE RIESLING: A semi dry white varietal wine with excellent varietal characters and lasting body.

VIDAL BLANC: A semi dry white varietal wine with a crisp fruity flavor.

COUNTRY BLUSH: A semi dry blend of hybrid wines with a clean, distinctive character.

CATAWBA: A semi dry white varietal wine with a spicy well balanced flavor and aroma.

GOLDEN CHABLIS: A semi dry white blend of wines that goes well with any occasion.

NIAGARA: A semi sweet white varietal wine with fruity characteristics.

VIN ROSE: A semi sweet light red blended wine and the favorite of many.

HAUT SAUTERNE: A sweet white wine blended for a pleasant, fruity aroma and taste.

PINK CATAWBA: A delicate sweet pink wine with spicy characteristics.

SWEET CONCORD: A sweet red varietal wine featuring the aroma and taste of the concord grapes.

CHERRY: A sweet full flavored red wine made from sour (pie) cherries. An excellent dessert wine or served hot with spices.

DELAWARE ICE WINE: A sweet dessert wine made from the juice of frozen grapes. A great value for ice wine.

CHAMPAGNES

CONTEMPORARY BLEND: A nearly dry blend of Seyval Blanc and Vidal Blanc grapes, reflecting the latest in Lake Erie hybrid wines.

WHITE RIESLING: A semi dry sparkling wine featuring a light fruitiness and delicate varietal characteristics.

TRADITIONAL BLEND: A slightly sweet blend of Catawba and Delaware grapes for a rich grape flavor. **Our Best Seller**
